## NCC to build Lyra, Örebro's new water reservoir

NCC is to build a new reservoir for the Municipality of Örebro to replace the existing Svampen reservoir. This will safeguard the water supply for a long time to come. The order is worth around SEK 150 million.

Lyra will be built in Adolfsberg, in the southern part of Örebro. The new reservoir will hold twice as much as the current Svampen water tower and will provide water to more than 160,000 residents.

"As chairman of the Technical Committee, I am very pleased that we can now break ground for Lyra, which will safeguard Örebro's water supply going forward," says Anders Ohlsson (C), chairman of the Technical Committee at the Municipality of Örebro.

Together, NCC and the Municipality of Örebro have managed to reduce the price by about 10 percent throughout the process.

"We have jointly looked at ways to reduce the cost throughout the negotiated procurement procedure. At NCC, we can see that there is potential in other projects as well if you work together in what is known as partnering, for example," says Henrik Enell, regional manager at NCC Infrastructure.

The municipality is looking forward to the completion of its new reservoir.

"Örebro is growing by about 2,000 residents per year, we are the sixth largest municipality in the country, and so water production also needs to evolve. Businesses in Örebro are also on the increase, as are healthcare and other activities, and we simply need more water than Svampen can provide," says Jenny Johrin, head of water and wastewater at the Municipality of Örebro.

The contract is worth around SEK 150 million and it will be registered among orders in the first quarter of 2020 in the NCC Infrastructure business area.
