NCC to build power plant at Skaraborg Hospital

NCC will be working together with Västfastigheter to build a new power plant for Skaraborg Hospital in Skövde. This is a turnkey contract in partnering form. The order is worth around SEK 150 million.

“Skaraborg Hospital in Skövde was built 50 years ago, and we will be carrying out a number of different refurbishments and improvements so as to adapt the buildings to a modern healthcare environment. The existing power plant needs to be replaced so as to ensure that the healthcare facilities continue to receive a vital and uninterrupted electricity supply,” says Håkan Sonesson, property manager at Västfastigheter.

NCC will be building a new high voltage and backup power plant at Skaraborg Hospital in Skövde. The building is a complete power plant that will supply the hospital with electricity and safeguard its future operation. The facility is around 2,500 square meters in area and will include switchgear and transformers, as well as five backup generators to ensure a continuous power supply.

“The existing power plant is not dimensioned to cope with the expansion that is taking place at the hospital, and we are now making a major effort to futureproof the power supply to the hospital. We have worked together with Västfastigheter to plan the contract carefully so as to ensure that construction is carried out as efficiently as possible while full operations are also ongoing in parallel at the hospital,” says Daniel Dahlberg, business manager at NCC Building Sweden.

The project is being implemented in partnering form, which is a form of cooperation based on close and open dialog while focusing on the best interests of the project. The parties have planned and designed the contract during the spring, and construction will start at the end of June. The plant is expected to be operational by the end of 2021, and the project should be completed in full by early 2022.

The contract of around SEK 150 million will be split in half between NCC Building Sweden and NCC Infrastructure business area, and the order will be registered in the second quarter of 2020.
