## NCC to build new swim center in Filipstad

**NCC will build a new swim center in Filipstad in cooperation with Filipstad Municipality. The project is a turnkey contract in partnering form. The order is valued at approximately SEK 190 million.**

“We are investing in public health and want to build a swim center that will benefit the residents of the municipality for several generations. We look forward to continuing our good collaboration with NCC and feel secure in its expertise in building swim and leisure centers,” says Åsa Hååkman Eriksson, Chair of the Filipstad Municipal Executive Board.

The project is being carried out in partnering form. In the first phase, NCC and Filipstad Municipality have jointly planned, designed and developed a target price for the new swim center. Now the parties have also signed an agreement for the construction of the center.

It will house a 25-metre pool with six lanes, a multifunction pool for swimming lessons and rehab, a family pool, and a sauna and warm pool. The entrance will feature a café, reception and changing rooms.

The facility is based on NCC’s swim center concept, which is developed through extensive experience and knowledge transfer from previous projects. There is a major focus on energy-efficient solutions, for instance, ventilation and water treatment will be optimized. In addition, solar cells will be installed.

“We are also building a new school and sports hall in Filipstad, which yields synergies between the projects and keeps costs down. NCC has solid experience of building swim and leisure centers, most recently from the swim center we built in Säffle. We are now looking forward to continuing to develop the area in cooperation with the municipality,” says Emilia Carlman, Production Manager, NCC Building Sweden.

The new center will be constructed on the same site as the previous one, at Spångbergshallen. NCC will commence work with the demolition of the old swim center, and construction of the new center is scheduled to start in April 2022. The swim center is expected to be completed at the end of 2023.

The assignment is valued at approximately SEK 190 million and will be registered among orders in the fourth quarter of 2021 in the NCC Building Sweden business area.
